- Interview 3 people born between 2000 and 2005
  - Must ask the following:
    - How is your generation different from millennials? That is, how are you different from those 10-ish years older than you?
    - What is the best and worst thing about your generation?
    - How are you typical and and atypical from your generation?
    - What social issues seem most important to your generation?
    - What social media do they use? Ask if you can see their feeds on Instagram, Snapchat and Tik Tok? What are their favorite feeds? Why?
    - What seem to be the top TV shows and movies?
    - Rule #1--Be curious!
- Dig deeper into Gen Z members' perspective on a certain topic
  - Ask your interviewees questions about your topic--
    - Jesus--What appeals to you about Jesus? What is threatening about Jesus? What does your generation think about Scripture? What is the place of spirituality and religion in your life? The life of your peers? Etc.
    - His people--What does your generation think about church? How do you make friends? What defines a good friends? How does one find a spouse? What defines a good marriage? Etc.

- His plan for the ends of the earth--Is America better, worse or about the same as other countries? How does your generation feel about politics? What international figures today or in the past do you admire? What is the place of missions--why does it matter? Etc.
