Pre-patriarchal Period

- Creation and Fall (Ge 1-3)
- The Flood (Ge 6-9)
- Tower of Babel (Ge 11:1-9)
- Story of Job

Patriarchal Period

- Life of Abraham (Ge 12-25)
 - * God's Covenant with Abraham (Ge 15)
- Life of Isaac (Ge 25-28)
- Life of Jacob (Ge 25-37)
- Life of Joseph (Ge 37-50)
- Israel goes to Egypt (Ge 46: 1-7)

The Exodus from Egypt

- Plagues & Passover (Ex 7 -12)
- Giving the Law & the Tabernacle (Ex 19-31)
- Wandering in the wilderness (Nu 10-21)

Conquest of Canaan

- Israelites begin to conquer (Nu 21-32)
- Joshua enters the promised land (Jos 3-24)
- Israelites fail to complete the conquest (Jdg 2:1-5)

Judges govern Israel

- Judges lead through cycles of persecution (Jdg 3-16)
- Civil war against Benjamin (Jdg 20-21)
- The story of Ruth (Ru 1:1-2; 4:13-17)
- The life of Samuel (1 Sa 1-25)

United Kingdom

- Life of Saul
 - * The Israelites ask Samuel for a king (1 Sa 8:4-5)
 - * God rejects Saul as king (1 Sa 15: 10-11)
- Life of David
 - * Samuel anoints David (1 Sa 16:1-33)
 - * God's covenant with David (2 Sa 7:1-17)
- Life of Solomon
 - * Solomon becomes king (1 Ki 2:12)
 - * Temple is constructed and dedicated (1 Ki 5-9)
 - * Solomon commits idolatry (1 Ki 11)

Divided Kingdom

- Jeroboam rebels against Rehoboam (1 Ki 12:20)
 - * Jeroboam leads northern tribes of Israel
 - * Rehoboam leads southern tribe of Judah
- David's line reigns in Judah (1 Ki 11 :43-15:23-24)
 - * Asa enacts reforms (2 Ch 14:2-8; 1 Ki 15:9-15)
- Coups and civil war in Israel (1 Ki 12-16)
- Omri's line reigns in Israel (1 Ki 16-2 Ki 8)
 - * King Ahab and the prophet Elijah (1 Ki 16-22)
- Jehoshaphat reigns in Judah (1 Ki 15-22)
 - * Elijah passes his ministry to Elisha (2 Ki 2:1-12)
- Jehu's line reigns in Israel (2 Ki 9-10)
 - * Jonah's prophetic career
- Judah's kings act in obedience (2 Ki 11-15)
 - * Amos's prophetic career
 - * Hosea's prophetic career
- Fall of Israel (2 Ki 15-17)
 - * Isaiah's early prophetic career (Is 6-8)
- Judah gives in to idolatry (2 Ki 15-16)

Assyrian Conquest

- Israel in Assyrian Exile
 - * Israel dispersed and Samaria resettled (2 Ki 17-18)
 - * Isaiah's late prophetic career (Is 20; 22)

Decline of Judah

- Micah prophesies against Jerusalem (Mic 3:9-12)
- King Hezekiah (2 Ki 18-20)
- Isaiah's prophesy against Sennacherib (Is 37:21-35)
- Assyria withdraws from Jerusalem (2 Ki 19:35-36)
- King Josiah (2 Ki 22-23)
 - * The book of the Law is found (2 Ki 22:3-13)
 - * Zephaniah prophesies
 - * Jeremiah's early prophetic career (Je 1-26)

Babylonian Captivity

- Judah's first defeat by Babylon (2 Ki 24:1)
- Siege of Jerusalem/Temple destroyed (2 K 25:8-21)
- Jews including Jeremiah are taken to Egypt (Je 43:1-7)
- Daniel's early prophetic career (Da 1-4)
 - * Ezekiel's prophetic career

Return from exile

- Persia reigns over the Jews (Da 5:30-31)
- Daniel's late prophetic career (Da 5-12)
- Cyrus makes a proclamation (2 Ch 36:22-23; Ear 1:1-4)
- The first group of exiles return (Ezr 1:5-11)
- Rebuilding the temple (Ezra)
 - * Haggai and Zechariah prophesy
- Story of Esther
- Rebuilding Jerusalem (Nehemiah)

New Testament

Jesus' life before ministry

- Births of Jesus and John the Baptist are foretold (Lk 1)
- Birth of Jesus (Mt 1-2)
- Jesus, Mary, and Joseph flee to Egypt (Mt 2:13-15)

Passion Week

- Jesus in Jerusalem (Mt 21-26)
- Last Supper with the Disciples (Mt 26; Lk 22; Jn 13)
- Last teachings (Mt 26:30-35; Jn 15-17)
- Jesus' trial (Mt 26-27; Lk 22-23)
- Jesus' crucifixion (Mt 27; Mk 15; Lk 23; Jn 19)
- Jesus' resurrection (Mt 28; Mk 16; Lk 24; Jn 20)

The Early Church
